YOU AND EACH OF YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the above-named Plaintiffs-Appellants hereby appeal to the District Court aforesaid the award made to the Plaintiffs-Appellants by the Compensation Commission on December 12, 1995, as damages for the Defendant's taking of the following-described real estate, towit:

A permanent easement for highway purposes:

A parcel of land located in the Southwest Quarter (SWM) of the Northeast Quarter (NEM) of Fractional Section Thirty (30), Township Seventy-six (76) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa, more particularly described as: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (SWM) of the Northeast Quarter (NEM) of said Fractional Section Thirty (30), thence North 1° 39'02" West 160.97 feet along the east line of said Southwest Quarter (SWM) of the Northeast Quarter (NEM) to a point on the former centerline of Primary Road No. 92, the Point of Beginning, thence northwesterly 531.58 feet along said former centerline on an 1145.92 foot radius curve, concave northeasterly and having a chord bearing North 56°21'49" West 526.82 feet, thence North 43°04'27" West 404.42 feet along said former centerline, thence North 46°55'33" Bast 33.09 feet to the point on the present northeasterly right of way line of Primary Road No. 92; thence South 66°19'02" Bast 206.19 feet, thence South 37°04'34" Bast 238.93 feet, thence southeasterly 393.31 feet along a 1427.89 foot radius curve, concave northeasterly and having a chord bearing South 64°12'21" Bast 392.06 feet to a point on the east line of the Southwest Quarter (SWM) of the Northeast Quarter (NEM) of said Section Thirty (30); thence South 1°39'02" Bast 165.85 feet along said east line to a point on the former centerline of Primary Road No. 92, the Point of Beginning; excepting therefrom present easements of record, containing 1.14 acres, exclusive of said exceptions;

STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT

COMES NOW the Plaintiffs, Thomas E. Helms and Barbara E. Helms, and the Defendant, Iowa Department of Transportation; and, in settlement of the above-captioned case hereby stipulate as follows:

- 1. Defendant, Iowa Department of Transportation, concedes that the pond to the north and west of Plaintiff's driveway, as it existed prior to condemnation, has been silted full due to the construction, and that the Defendant, through its contractor, will remove the dam and old driveway and push the dirt to the north and west and sloped away from house.
- 2. Defendant, Iowa Department of Transportation, will rock the new driveway this fall and in the spring of 1997 pursuant to the oral agreement between Plaintiffs and the resident engineer.
- 3. Defendant, Iowa Department of Transportation, will pay one thousand dollars (\$1,000) in attorney fees to Plaintiffs' attorneys and the costs of this action.
 - 4. Plaintiffs will dismiss this appeal.
- 5. All parties agree that Section 6B.52 of the Code of Iowa still applies and that the Plaintiffs will have the time allowed by said statute from the date of the execution of this stipulation to renegotiate any other construction or maintenance damage not apparent at this time; and, that this

stipulation will be considered written notice to the Plaintiffs of such right of renegotiation. However, it is acknowledged by the Plaintiff that they claimed at the compensation commission their existing well requires replacement, as the result of the acquisition.

- 6. Plaintiffs and Defendant, Iowa Department of Transportation, agree that Madison County, Iowa, was named as a Defendant solely for the reason that they were a lienholder based on the second half of the real estate taxes payable in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1996, and it is not necessary for the Defendant, Madison County, Iowa, to be a party to this stipulation.
- 7. Plaintiffs shall be entitled to retain the award made by the condemnation commission which has been previously paid.
