RESOLUTION OF CITY OF WINTERSET, IOWA PROPOSING TO CONVEY REAL ESTATE AND SETTING PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, the City proposes to dispose of and sell its interest in certain real estate, legally described as:

The North 40 feet of Lots 3 & 4, Block 2 of the Original Town of Winterset, Madison County, Iowa.
