- 6 INSURANCE. Except as may be otherwise included in the tast sentence of paragraph 1(b) above, Buyers as and from said date of possession, shall constantly keep in force insurance, premiums therefore to be prepaid by Buyers (without notice or demand) against loss by fire, tomado and other hazards, casuattes and contingencies as Sellers may reconsist to be reasonably and improvements, now on or hereafter placed on each premiums the property of which may be the subject of this contract, in companies to be reasonably approved by Sellers in an amount not less than the full insurable value of such improvements and personal property or not less than the unsurance payable to Sellers and Buyers as their interests may appear.
