RESOLUTION

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Madison County, Iowa,

That on the 24th day of June, 1969, the Madison County Zoning Commission, after proper notification and the publishing of public hearing, did hold public meeting in regard to the application of Martha Street for a land use change, namely, from that of Agricultural to that of Commercial use of the following described real estate, to-wit:

Commencing at the intersection of the South and East lines of the highways on the North and West sides of the Southwest fractional quarter (SW FRL $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31 in Township Seventy-seven (77) North of Range twenty-seven (27) West of the Fifth P.M., running thence South 320 feet, thence East 558 feet, thence North 320 feet thence West 558 feet to the point of beginning.

Following said hearing, the Zoning Commission met and by resolution does hereby recommend to the Madison County Board of Supervisors that the above described real estate, now zoned Agricultural be rezoned to that of Commercial, permit fee to be \$15.00.
