### SATISFACTION OF MORTGAGE

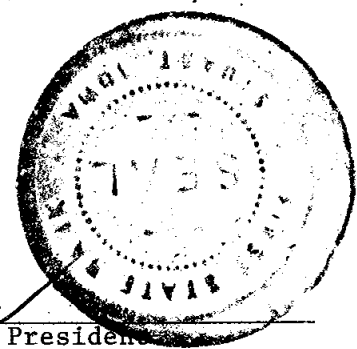
