DATA PROCESSING DISASTER RECOVERY AGREEMENT BETWEEN DALLAS COUNTY, IOWA AND MADISON COUNTY, IOWA.

Come now, the governing bodies of Dallas County and Madison County, Iowa, municipal corporations, and enter into an agreement of reciprocal support for data processing in the event of a disaster which renders data processing unavailable in either county.

This agreement is entered into pursuant to the provisions of chapter 28 E of the Iowa Code.

<u>Purpose</u>. Dallas County and Madison County hereby enter into a reciprocal agreement for data processing time sensitive work in the event of a disaster that would make use of data processing equipment in either county unavailable.

The County experiencing the disaster hereby agrees to place an immediate order for replacement equipment thus keeping the use of the other county's equipment to a minimum.

The County experiencing the disaster will contact the vendor, Solutions, Inc. or it's replacement, to provide replacement application programs and personnel to assist in recovery from the disaster.

The supporting county will make data processing equipment and software available to the county experiencing the disaster. No charge will be made to the supporting county for the reasonable use of the county's equipment. The loaned equipment may be physically moved to the supported county, or the supporting county may merely allow the supported county personnel to access equipment, at the option of the supporting county.

<u>Duration</u>. This agreement is perpetual, subject to termination as set forth herein.

<u>Administration</u>. Administration of this agreement is jointly by the respective auditors of the counties signing hereto. No property of any kind shall accrue to, nor need to be held or disposed of pursuant to this agreement. Each county is responsible for purchasing equipment and software.

<u>Financing</u>. No separate budget or financing is contemplated pursuant to this agreement. Each county budgets for their own contingencies. Use of the other county's equipment and software pursuant to this agreement is without cost to the supported county.

<u>Termination</u>. Either county may terminate participation in this agreement by giving 30 days mail notice to the board of supervisors of the other county.

This agreement is effective on filing and recording of the agreement duly passed by the governing bodies of each county, and attested thereby, is signed hereto by the respective chairs of the Boards of Supervisors.
