## AFFIDAVIT EXPLANATORY OF TITLE


"146. In cases of legal transfers of property or of legal contracts involving the church property, a two thirds majority vote of the members present in a regular business meeting of the church or in a called business meeting which has been announced one week previously shall be necessary to grant the trustees the right to make such transfers or to enter into such contracts. In case a local church desires to transfer its property to another religious body or to sell or dispose of its property, in no case shall this be legal or permissible except first a written permission is granted by the State Council in which state the property is located; said article of permission must be signed by the President and Secretary and the State Council seal affixed. Intent and purpose of said sale or transfer shall be made in writing to the State Council for the aforesaid permission."

- 4. The above quoted requirements of Section H (146) have been fully satisfied and complied with through the procedures set forth, and evidenced by, the following documents, copies of which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference:
  - a. Application for Article of Permission.
  - b. Article of Permission to Sell Real Property.

- 5.
