The City of St. Charles and the Grantor have agreed to the following to elements as an addition to the Temporary Easement:

- 1. Replacing the grass removed between the houses with sod at the most cost effective to the City.
 - a. with the option of the City cutting the sod and the property owner replacing the cut sod between the houses.
- 2. Replacing the grass removed from the front yard with athletic turf mix @ Earl May Nursery.
 - a. with the option of the City supplying the property owner the money to by and maintain the seed.
- 3. Replacing any trees, shrubs, plants, landscaping rock, and weed block fabric of the same kind and size (work to be done by Miller Nursery of Johnston, IA) due to damage incurred during construction.
- 4. Positive drainage from front and side yard to flow away from house foundation and grading of drainage swell to be approved by the home owner.
