## **RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Chapter 306 of the Code of Iowa provides that the Board of Supervisors has the authority to establish, alter or vacate any highway under its jurisdiction and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held in the office of the Madison County Board of Supervisors at 10:00 A.M., Tuesday, April 30, 2002, pursuant to notice, in regard to vacating and abandoning the following described road(s):

## **JACKSON TOWNSHIP, SECTION 30**

That part of a county road platted April 4, 1900, in Road Record Book 4, Page 14, in the Madison County Engineer's Office, Madison County, Iowa, located in the Southeast Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of Section 30, Township 76 North, Range 29 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, and also the Southwest Quarter of Section 29, of said Township and Range, vacate as follows;

Commencing at the southeast corner of said Section 30; thence west along the section line between said Section 30 and Section 31, of said Township and Range, to the eastern right of way of the county road between Madison and Adair County established December 6<sup>th</sup>, 1869, on file in Road Record Book A, Page 396, Madison County Engineer's Office, Madison County, Iowa.

WHEREAS, no written or oral objections or claims for damages were received,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the aforesaid road(s), as described, be vacated and any right, title or interest be abandoned.
