

## **LEGAL DESCRIPTION:**

A parcel located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 75 North, Range 28 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Madison County, Iowa, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 75 North, Range 28 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., Madison County, Iowa; thence South 89°19'22" East, 1257.21 feet along the North line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 12 to a point on the centerline of an existing County Road; thence South 3°02'40" West, 60.81 feet along said road centerline; thence Southwesterly 283.91 feet along said road centerline, which is a 229.19 foot radius curve, concave Northwesterly, with a chord of South 38°31'55" West, 266.10 feet; thence South 74°01'10" West, 575.12 feet along said road centerline; thence Southwesterly 316.07 feet along said road centerline, which is a 1145.93 foot radius curve, concave Southeasterly, with a chord of South 66°07'04" West, 315.06 feet; thence South 88°18'56" West, 258.08 feet to a point on the West line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 12; thence North 1°04'27" East, 577.32 feet along the West line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 12 to the Point of Beginning. Said Parcel contains 11.873 acres, including 0.949 acres of County Road right-of-way.
