This is to confirm that the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) received your March 28, 2002 letter concerning the title change by First Union National Bank of Delaware accompanied by the appropriate amendment to the Bank's articles of association. The OCC has recorded that as of April 1, 2002, the title of First Union National Bank of Delaware, Wilmington, Delaware, Charter Nr. 22559, was changed to Wachovia Bank of Delaware, National Association.

As a result of the Garn-St. Germain Depository Institutions Act of 1982, the OCC is no longer responsible for the approval of national bank name changes nor does it maintain official records on the use of alternate titles. The retention of the rights to any previously used title is the responsibility of the Bank's board of directors. Legal counsel should be consulted to determine whether or not the new title, or previously used title, could be challenged by competing institutions under the provisions of federal or state law.
