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ALIMONY

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that neither the Plaintiff nor the Defendant is awarded alimony, and alimony is forever barred.

ATTORNEY FEES

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that each party shall be responsible for their own attorney fees.

RESTORATION OF FORMER NAME

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the former name of the Defendant herein, namely NORMA K. COY, shall be and the same is hereby restored to her.

PROPERTY SETTLEMENT

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Plaintiff, THOMAS G. WILSON, shall be, and he is hereby awarded the following assets as his sole and separate property, free and clear of any right, title, interest or claim of the Defendant, NORMA K. WILSON:

1. One and one-half acre lot located in Springfield, Missouri, more fully described as follows:

Lot eleven (11) in Oak Bridge, a Subdivision in Christian County, Missouri (amended to Country Gate on July 20, 1990), A Subdivision in Christian County, Missouri, according to Plat filed in Plat Book G, Page 143, Recorder's Office of Christian County, Missouri.

free and clear of any claim by the Defendant herein. Defendant shall execute a Quit Claim Deed thereon, to the Plaintiff, forthwith upon entry of this Judgment. Should she fail to do so, title may be transferred as set forth hereinafter in the "Implementation" Paragraph.

2. Farm house located in Winterset, Iowa, more fully described as follows:

The North 20 rods of the East 16 rods of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Seven (7), Township Seventy-five (75) North, Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa.

and shall continue to receive any and all payments under a certain Land Contract thereon. Defendant shall execute a Quit Claim Deed thereon, to the Plaintiff, forthwith upon entry of this Judgment. Should she fail to do so, title may be transferred as set forth hereinafter in the "Implementation" Paragraph.

3. All items of personal property presently in his possession.

4. Any and all bank accounts presently in his own name.

5. The 1964 AMC Rambler automobile, VIN#B671422, presently registered in his name. The Plaintiff hereby agrees to assume and pay any and all payments on said vehicle and agrees to hold the Defendant harmless in regards thereto.

6. The 1972 Champion Motor Home, VIN#1024352.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Defendant, NORMA K. WILSON, shall be and she is hereby awarded the following assets as her sole and separate property, free and clear of any right, title, interest or claim of the Plaintiff, THOMAS G. WILSON:

1. All items of personal property presently in her possession.

2. The 1993 Chevrolet Cavalier automobile presently registered in her name. The Defendant hereby agrees to assume and pay any and all payments on said vehicle and agrees to hold the Plaintiff harmless in regards thereto.

3. Any and all bank accounts presently in her own name.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Plaintiff, THOMAS G. WILSON, agrees to assume and pay any and all debts presently in his name alone and agrees to hold the Defendant harmless in regards thereto, and shall indemnify the Defendant for any liability arising therefrom from this date on.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Defendant, NORMA K. WILSON agrees to assume and pay any and all debts presently in her name alone and agrees to hold the Plaintiff harmless in regards thereto and shall indemnify Plaintiff for any liability arising therefrom from this date on.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that each of the parties warrant that they have made a true disclosure of all assets and liabilities and income sources, whether held individually, in joint names, in the name of a third party or otherwise, and further, that each has relied upon such statements and has acted in accordance with those disclosures in arriving at this property settlement.

PENSION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Plaintiff shall receive his pension through his employer free and clear of any claims of the Defendant in regards thereto.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Defendant shall receive her pension through her employer free and clear of any claims by the Plaintiff in regards thereto.

C.O.B.R.A. PROVISION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Defendant may remain on the Plaintiff's health insurance plan, through the Navy, by a C.O.B.R.A Order, if applicable, for a period of thirty-six (36) months, premiums to be paid by Defendant.

DOWER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the provisions made in this Judgment of Divorce shall be in full and complete satisfaction of each party's claim to the other party's real and personal property, and each party hereafter shall hold his or her real and personal property free and clear of the dower claims of the other party.

INSURANCE

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that except as otherwise provided herein, all rights of either party in and to the proceeds of any policy or contract of life insurance, endowment, or annuity upon the life of the other in which said party was named or designated as beneficiary, or to which said party became entitled by assignment or change of beneficiary during the marriage or in anticipation thereof, whether such contract or policy was heretofore or shall hereafter be written or become effective, shall hereupon become and be payable to the estate of the owner of said policy, or such named beneficiary as shall hereafter be affirmatively designated.

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IMPLEMENTATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the parties hereto shall sign and execute such documents as may be necessary and expediate to carry out the terms of the property settlement portion of this Judgment. However, in the event that the parties hereto or either of them shall neglect, fail or refuse to do so, then and in that event, the filing of a true copy of the Judgment of Divorce, incorporating the terms of the property settlement, with the Register of Deeds, Secretary of State and such other offices as may be necessary to carry out the conveyances and transfers ordered herein shall act in the place of the same, and to the same effect as if said documents and instruments were duly signed and executed as ordered herein.

RETENTION OF JURISDICTION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Court retains jurisdiction to interpret and enforce any and all provisions of the Judgment of Divorce.

PAYMENT OF STATUTORY FEES

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that all statutory fees required to be paid pursuant to MCL 600.2529 shall be paid by the parties hereto forthwith.
