The Affiant is the duly appointed and acting Trustee of the Walter W. and Mary C. Addy Trust under Trust Agreement, dated November 3, 2000. The creators of the Trust were Walter Wyman Addy and Mary Catharine Addy who were husband and wife until the death of Walter Wyman Addy. The Trust Agreement was revocable and provided the creators of the Trust during the lives of the creators, or the survivor of them, a right to all the income and the principal of the Trust. The Trustee was specifically granted the power to sell real estate held by the Trust.

Walter Wyman Addy died on June 23, 2001 in Winterset, Madison County, Iowa. Mary Catharine Addy died on November 15, 2001 in Winterset, Madison County, Iowa. At the time of their deaths, the total value of all assets owned by Walter Wyman Addy and Mary Catharine Addy and the Walter W. and Mary C. Addy Trust were substantially less than \$675,000.00. Under the terms of the Trust Agreement, after the death Walter Wyman Addy, Mary Catherine Addy solely had the right to all income and principal of the Trust. Under the Iowa Inheritance Tax laws providing for unlimited marital exemption, no Iowa Inheritance Tax was due the State of Iowa as a result of the death of Walter Wyman Addy.

Further, the Affiant has made diligent inquiry to ascertain the identity of all creditors of Walter Wyman Addy and Mary Catharine Addy and the Walter W. and Mary C. Addy Trust and has satisfied all such claims.
