Said property will be used for motocross – 5 annual races and occasional practice events

Parcel area included in Special Use Permit:

Parcel E NW NE containing 1.744 acres AND Lots 1 & 2 NW NE and Lot 2 NE NE ex Parcel C & D NW NE and Parcel F N 1/2 NE Section 14 T75N R28W Lincoln Township

Set backs shall be maintained in accordance with the Madison County Zoning Ordinance

Parking shall be within the area included in the Special Use Permit

There shall not be any lighting or night-time operations

The surface of the Motocross tracks shall be watered for dust control during operations

An ambulance shall be on site for all races. The ingress / egress shall be kept open so emergency equipment can pass.

No vehicles shall be allowed to park on highway during track operation

No motorcycles shall be ridden outside closed motocross course during operation.

Safety fences shall be in place to keep spectators off the track. Trained flagmen shall be used during races to ensure rider safety.

An adequate number of portable toilets shall be supplied and maintained in accordance with the Environmental Health Regulations.

An adequate number of covered trash barrels shall be supplied and maintained.

Area included in the Special Use Permit is buffered by surrounding trees and sets within a valley
