


Voluntary annexation

The City of Winterset has received an Application for Voluntary Annexation from Jerry & Beth Schwertfeger for a tract of land located just north of the existing Winterset city boundary, at the far north end of the City. State law now requires that a consultation meeting with the Board of Supervisors and the Trustees of the township that contains the territory to be annexed be held before the City Council can consider the annexation application.

The purpose of this letter is to provide notice of a consultation meeting on the Application for Voluntary Annexation from Jerry & Beth Schwertfeger. This consultation meeting will be held on June 27, 2003 at 1:00 PM at the Winterset City Hall.

State Code provides that the County and the Township may designate one of its members to attend the consultation meeting. The Code also provides that you may make written recommendations for modification to the proposed annexation within seven business days after the consultation meeting. State law also provides that not later than 30 days after the consultation, the Board of Supervisors shall, by resolution, state whether or not it supports the annexation application or whether it takes no position on the annexation application. A copy of this resolution is to be filed with the annexing city and shall be considered by the City Council when taking action on the application.

Enclosed is a copy of the Application for Voluntary Annexation together with the legal description of the property, and a map showing the location of the property in relationship to the existing city boundary.

Minutes from Schwertfeger annexation consultation meeting held June 27, 2003:

Persons present:

Cy McDonald, Madison County Board of Supervisors
Dan Ryner and Randy Molln, Union Township Trustees
Mark Nitchals, City Administrator of the City of Winterset

The meeting began with an explanation of the area proposed to be annexed. Mr. Nitchals explained that the Schwertfegers wanted to sell some land to Phil Clifton and Ron Wass. He stated that Jerry Schwertfeger had informed him that the County wanted the land annexed so that it would be classified and taxed the same as the properties owned by Clifton and Wass, which were located within the City of Winterset.

Dan Ryner stated that he owns land adjacent to the east of the land proposed for annexation. He stated that he would like the City to help him get the fence repaired or replaced between his property and the land in the Schwertfeger development. He stated that years ago his Dad and the person who owned the land that makes up the Schwertfeger development had each replaced their respective half of the fence. Mr. Ryner stated he has maintained the portion of the fence his Dad built, but the south end of the fence has not been maintained as well. Mr. Ryner explained that he turns his cows out in this area during the winter months, and there needs to be good fences to keep his cattle from getting our and possibly getting over to Highway 169. There are now several landowners, including Curtis Allen, John Reed, Ron Wass, and Jerry Schwertfeger, and Mr. Ryner stated that it is difficult to maintain fence agreements with each of these owners for a relatively short section of fence. Mr. Ryner suggested that the City require the developer to build new fences in new residential subdivisions that are developed out in areas where agriculture practices are still being done.

Following this discussion, the meeting was adjourned.
