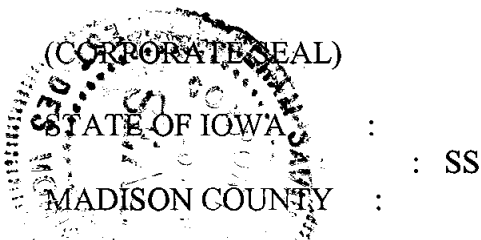
### REASSIGNMENT OF ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT

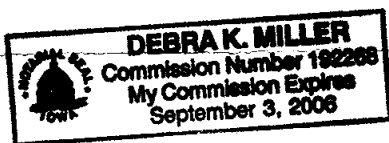
