The undersigned affiants further state that they are fully informed and knowledgeable of all prior conveyances and fractions thereof of the real estate herebefore described. The Quit Claim Deed from Hawkeye Land Company, a/k/a Hawkeye Land Co., an Iowa corporation, to Joy Bricker and filed of record October 6, 1986, in the Office of the Madison County Recorder in Book 122, Page 382 conveyed to Joy Bricker all of their right, title and interest in and to the main track right-of-way of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad Company described as being approximately 200 feet in width.
