thence northwesterly along the present right of way line of Madison County Highway G-50 to a point that is 70.00 feet North 40 degrees 10 seconds 00 minutes East of centerline station 347+44.00 of Madison County Highway Project SN-299(5), (1968), (G-50) and the termination of said line.
