EASEMENT

and locally known as <u>3351 St. Charles Rd.</u>
together with the right of ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the GRANTORS, their successors and assigns, for the purposes of this easement

The Easement shall be 32 feet in width, the centerline of which shall be the water pipeline and the necessary appurtenances thereto

It is agreed that, during the period of initial construction, no crop damage will be paid by the GRANTEE The GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, hereby promise to maintain such water pipeline and any necessary appurtenances in good repair so that damage to adjacent real estate of GRANTORS, if any damage there be, will be kept to a minimum

The grant and other provisions of this easement shall constitute a covenant running with the land for the benefit of the GRANTEE, its successors and assigns
