

TWO YEAR INITIAL SERVICE POLICY

Date: April 27, 1995 - 1997

Our firm, NASH WELL CO. MILO, IA., will inspect and service your Clearstream System for the first two years from the date of installation. There will be two inspections made each year for this initial two year period. Effluent quality inspection will include a visual inspection for color, turbidity, sludge build up, scum overflow and odor. Mechanical and electrical inspection and service include inspecting aerator, air filter, and alarm panel and replacing or repairing any component not found to be functioning correctly.

Also to collect effluent samples and report B.O.D. results to the County Health Dept. as required for the initial 24 month period.

Upon expiration of this policy, our firm will offer a continuing service policy on a yearly basis to cover labor for normal maintenance and repairs on a year by year basis.

(This service contract and B.O.D. tests maybe required in your county by an authorized dealer of Clearstream.)

Violations of warranty include shutting off the electric current to the system for more than 24 hours, disconnecting the alarm system, restricting ventilation to the aerator, overloading the system above it's rated capacity, or introducing excessive amounts of harmful matter into the system, or any other form of unusual abuse.
