## AFFIDAVIT

The undersigned Donald Bark, upon being duly sworm, does hereby depose and state as follows:

The affiant is Donald Burk who is the child of Elmer Burk who was also known as Elmer F. Burk. Elmer Burk died on December 2, 1969 at Bevington, Madison County, Iowa. Elmer Burk at death was survived by a spouse who was Katherine M. Burk and four (4) children who are the affiant Donald Burk, Linda Burk who is now known as Linda Rhinehart, Michael Burk, and Helen Burk.

The decedent Elmer Burk died intestate and his estate has never been administered.

At death, Elmer Burk owned as joint tenants with his spouse Katherine M. Burk the real estate legally described as:
