## FAUX - NEWHOUSE REAL ESTATE CONTRACT - EXHIBIT "A"

## Description of Real Estate:

Parcel "B", located in the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Seventy-six (76) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (1/2) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Seventy-six (76) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa; thence South 85°57'56" West along the north line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 15, 1322.60 feet to the northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 15; thence South 0°00'00" West along the west line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 15, 1146.36 feet to a point in the centerline of an unpaved county road; thence North 55°38'48" East along said road centerline, 535.68 feet; thence North 41°29'10" East along said road centerline, 1121.71 feet; thence North 54°08'59" East along said road centerline, 165.33 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 18.607 acres, including 1.490 acres of county road right-ofway.

## **Additional Provisions:**

- 1. Buyers acknowledge that they have made a satisfactory inspection of the property and are purchasing the property in its existing condition, "as is".
- 2. In the event Buyers are delinquent in making a monthly payment due on this contract three or more times in any 12-month period, Seller shall have the right to declare the entire balance to be immediately due and payable. There shall be a 10-day grace period for any payment due on this contract.
- 3. In the event Buyers sell all or any part of the above-described real estate, or assign this contract, Seller shall have the right to declare the entire balance to be immediately due and payable.
