KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

RO-BANKS WELL CO. INC., hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS, in consideration of One Dollar and Other Valuable Consideration, hereby grant and convey unto **CITY OF ST. CHARLES, IOWA**, hereinafter referred to as GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement with the right to remove certain lines and appurtenances thereto, over, across, and through the land of the GRANTORS, situated in: **THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, MADISON COUNTY, IOWA**, being more specifically described as follows:

An Easement 10 feet in width running North and South across the following described real estate:

The East Ten (10) feet of Lot #5, Elephant's Second Addition to the City of St. Charles, Iowa,

together with the right of ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the GRANTORS, their successors and assigns, for the purposes of this easement.

The Easement shall be 10 feet in width, the east line of which shall be the water pipeline and the necessary appurtenances thereto, along with an adjacent temporary Construction Easement 10 feet in width for construction purposes.

It is agreed that, during the period of initial construction, the GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, hereby promise to maintain such water pipeline and any necessary appurtenances in good repair so that damage to adjacent real estate of GRANTORS, if any damage there be, will be kept to a minimum.

The grant and other provisions of these easements shall constitute a covenant running with the land for the benefit of the GRANTEE, its successors and assigns.


