COMES NOW the Indianola Municipal Utilities and states that the public interest requires that certain rights be acquired in agricultural land legally described in the attached Exhibit "A", by condemnation proceedings, as authorized and provided by law.

Attached as Exhibit "B" are plats showing the location of the right-of-way easements sought to be condemned with reference to each legal description given in Exhibit "A".

Attached as Exhibit "C" are the names of all owners of record of the tracts of land sought to be condemned, or otherwise affected by these proceedings, and the names of all record holders of liens and encumbrances on such lands, as well as place of residence of all such persons so far as is known to the applicant.

The Indianola Municipal Utilities desires right-of-way easements over the agricultural land sought to be condemned for the purpose of constructing, operating, replacing, repairing, and maintaining, or in moving at its option, an electric transmission and distribution line(s), including all necessary poles, cross arms, guy wires, anchors, and overhang for the transmission and distribution of electric current for any purpose whatsoever, including the right to cut and trim trees and shrubbery to the extent necessary to keep them clear of the electric lines or that may interfere with or threaten to endanger the operation or maintenance of the lines.

The Indianola Municipal Utilities has been unable to secure the described easement rights by purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Indianola Municipal Utilities hereby requests the appointment of a compensation commission of six (6) persons qualified as prescribed in Iowa Code Section 472.4 not interested in the same or like question, to view the real estate involved and appraise damages which the owners, lien

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holders, encumbrances or other interested persons will sustain by reason of the land sought to be condemned for the purpose stated and make the report in writing to the Sheriff as provided by law.


