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- a. If Buyers fall to timely perform this contract, the Sellers may forfell it as provided in The Code, and all payments made shall be forfelted or, at Seller's option, upon thirty days written notice of intention to accelerate the payment of the entire balance because of such fallure (during which thirty days such fallure is not corrected) Sellers may declare the entire balance immediately due and payable. Thereafter this contract may be foreclosed in equity; the Court may appoint a receiver; and the period of redemption after sale on toreclosure may be reduced under the conditions of Section 628.28 or Section 628.27 of The Code.
 b. If Sellers fall to timely perform this contract, Buyers have the right to have all payments made returned to them.
- Buyers and Sellers are also entitled to utilize any and all other remedies or actions at law or in equity available to them.
- d. In any ection or proceeding relating to this contract the successful party shall be entitled to receive reasonable attorney's fees and costs as permitted by law.
- 12. JOINT TENANCY IN PROCEEDS AND IN REAL ESTATE. If Sellers, immediately preceding this contract, hold title to the Real Estate in joint tenancy with full right of survivorable, and the joint tenancy is not later destroyed by operation of law or by acts of the Setters, then the proceeds of this sets, and any continuing or recaptured rights of Setters in the Real Estate, shall belong to Setters as joint tenants with full right of survivorable and not as tenants in common; and Buyers, in the event of the death of either Setter, agree to pay any balance of the price due Setters under this contract to the surviving Setter and to accept a deed from the surviving Setter consistent with paragraph 10.
- 13. JOINDER BY SELLER'S SPOUSE.
