

This Indenture, Made the 11th day of May 19<sup>87</sup>, by and between Paul D. Welch Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa, of the first part, and United Federal Savings Bank of Iowa fka United Federal Savings and Loan Association of Des Moines of the County of Madison in the State of Iowa of the second part, witnesseth:

THAT WHEREAS, By virtue of a Special execution directed to Paul D. Welch the then acting Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa, dated the 25th day of February A. D. 19<sup>86</sup>, and issued out of the Clerk's office of the District Court of the State of Iowa, in and for Madison County, under the seal of said Court, upon a judgment rendered in said District Court, on the 25th day of February A. D. 19<sup>86</sup>, United Federal Savings Bank of Iowa fka United Federal Savings and Loan in favor of Association of Des Moines,

and against Herbert L. Benge, Wilma Sue Benge et al for the sum of Eleven thousand Six hundred eight dollars and seventeen cents Dollars (\$ 11,608.17) debt, costs, interest and accruing costs, the said Paul D. 


