- 8. **FIXTURES.** All property that integrally belongs to or is part of the Real Estate, whether attached or detached, such as light fixtures, shades, rods, blinds, awnings, windows, storm doors, screens, plumbing fixtures, water heaters, water softeners, automatic heating equipment, air conditioning equipment, wall to wall carpeting, built-in items and electrical service cable, outside television towers and antenna, fencing, gates and landscaping shall be considered a part of Real Estate and included in the sale except: (Consider: Rental items.)
- 9. **CARE OF PROPERTY.** Buyers shall take good cafe of the property; shall keep the buildings and other improvements now or later placed on the Real Estate in good and reasonable repair and shall not injure, destroy or remove the property during the life of this contract. Buyers shall not make any material alteration to the Real Estate without the written consent of the Sellers.
- 10. **DEED.** Upon payment of purchase price, Sellers shall convey the Real Estate to Buyers or their assignees, by warranty deed, free and clear of all liens, restrictions, and encumbrances except as provided in 1.a. through 1.d. Any general warranties of title shall extend only the date of this contract, with special warranties as to acts of Sellers continuing up to time of delivery of the deed.

11. REMEDIES OF THE PARTIES.

- a. If Buyers fail to timely perform this contract, the Sellers may forfeit it as provided in The Code, and all payments made shall be forfeited or, at Seller's option, upon thirty days written notice of intention to accelerate the payment of the entire balance because of such failure (during which thirty days such failure is not corrected) Sellers may declare the entire balance immediately due and payable. Thereafter this contract may be foreclosed in equity; the Court may appoint a receiver; and the period of redemption after sale on foreclosure may be reduced under the conditions of Section 628.26 or Section 628.27 of The Code.
- b. If Sellers fail to timely perform this contract, Buyers have the right to have all payments made returned to them.
- c. Buyers and Sellers are also entitled to utilize any and all other remedies or actions at law or in equity available to them.
- "d. In any action or proceeding relating to this contract the successful party shall be entitled to receive reasonable attorney's fees and costs as permitted by law.
- 12. **JOINT TENANCY IN PROCEEDS AND IN REAL ESTATE.** If Sellers, immediately preceding this contract, hold title to the Real Estate in joint tenancy with full right of survivorship, and the joint tenancy is not later destroyed by operation of law or by acts of the Sellers, then the proceeds of this sale, and any continuing or recaptured rights of Sellers in the Real Estate, shall belong to Sellers as joint tenants with full right of survivorship and not as tenants in common; and Buyers, in the event of the death of either Seller, agree to pay any balance of the price due Sellers under this contract to the surviving Seller and to accept a deed from the surviving Seller consistent with paragraph 10.
- 13. **JOINDER BY SELLER'S SPOUSE.** Seller's spouse, if not a titleholder immediately preceding acceptance of this offer, executes this contract only for the purpose of relinquishing all rights of dower, homestead and distributive share or in compliance with Section 516.13 of The Code and agrees to execute the deed for this purpose.
 - 14. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE. Time is of the essence in this contract.
- 15. **PERSONAL PROPERTY.** If this contract includes the sale of any personal property, the Buyers grant the Sellers a security interest in the personal property and Buyers shall execute the necessary financing statements and deliver them to Sellers.
- 16. **CONSTRUCTION.** Words and phrases in this contract shall be construed as in the singular or plural number, and as masculine, feminine or neuter gender, according to the context.

Description of real estate:

A parcel of land located in the North Half (1/2) of the Southwest Fractional Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Seventy-seven (77) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of the Southwest Fractional Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Seventy-seven (77) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa; thence along the South line of the North Half (1/2) of said Southwest Fractional Quarter (1/4), North 90 degrees 00' 00" West 736.33 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence continuing along said South line, North 90 degrees 00' 00" West 588.41 feet; thence North 00 degrees 13' 47" East 391.83 feet; thence South 90 degrees 00' 00" East 590.91 feet; thence South 00 degrees 35' 42" West 391.85 feet to the Point of Beginning. Said parcel of land contains 5.304 acres including 0.366 acres of county road right of way.

Payment provisions:

\$500.00 on principal on or before June 1, 1988; \$282.73 on May 1, 1988; and \$282.73 on the first day of each month thereafter until all sums are paid in full. Said monthly payments shall be applied first to the interest then unpaid and next upon the balance of the principal. Buyer shall have the right to prepay all or any part of the principal without penalty. The parties agree that the principal payment due on June 1, 1988, shall not bear interest if timely paid.

Additional provisions:

Buyer and his successors and assigns shall maintain and keep in repair the fences located on the East, North and West boundary lines of the above-described real estate. If the parties docide to replace the North houndary fence, the cost of materials and labor for such fence shall be shared equally by Buyer and Sellers. After completion of construction of said fence, said fence shall be maintained and kept in repair by Buyer, his successors and cooligns.
