- Sellers shall complete the following work on the property on or before January 2, 1988:
 - a. Closing off the former parts window and the door north of the parts window from the Sellers' building to the west with concrete block.
 - b. Repairing the hole in the ceiling about 20 feet from the north wall under the overhead door when it is up with material comparable with existing material.
