

This Indenture, Made the 7th day of October 19.86, by and between

Paul D. Welch Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa, of the first part,  
and Home Plan Savings and Loan Association

of the County of Madison in the State of Iowa of the second part, witnesseth:

THAT WHEREAS, By virtue of a Special execution directed to  
Paul D. Welch the then acting Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa,  
dated the 8th day of January A. D. 19.86, and issued out of the Clerk's office of the  
District Court of the State of Iowa, in and for Madison County, under the seal of said Court, upon a  
judgment rendered in said District Court, on the 6th day of January A. D. 19.86,  
in favor of Home Plan Savings and Loan Association  
and against Joel A. Fitzgerald, Karen K. Fitzgerald, et al for the sum of  
Six thousand Eight hundred fifty-six dollars and no cents - - - Dollars (\$ 6,856.00)
