7. ABSTRACT AND TITLE. Sellers, at their expense, shall promptly obtain an abstract of title to the Real Estate continued through the date of this contract, and deliver it to Buyers for examination. It shall show merchantable title in Sellers in conformity with this agreement, lowa law and the Title Standards of the lowa State Bar Association. The abstract shall become the property of the Buyers when the purchase price is paid in full, however, Buyers reserve the right to occasionally use the abstract prior to full payment of the purchase price. Sellers shall pay the costs of any additional abstracting and title work due to any act or omission of Sellers, including transfers by or the death of Sellers or their assignees.	
8. FIXTURES. All property that integrally belongs to or is part of the Real Estate, whether attached or detached, such as light fixtures, shades, rods, blinds, awnings, windows, storm doors, screens, plumbing fixtures, water heaters, water softeners, automatic heating equipment, air conditioning equipment, wall to wall carpeting, built-in items and electrical service cable, outside television towers and antenna, fencing, gates and landscaping shall be considered a part of Real Estate and included in the sale except: (Consider: Rental items.)	
9. CARE OF PROPERTY. Buyers shall take good cafe of the property; shall keep the buildings and other improvements now or later placed on the Real Estate in good and reasonable repair and shall not injure, destroy or remove the property during the life of this contract. Buyers shall not make any material alteration to the Real Estate without the written consent of the Sellers.	
10. DEED. Upon payment of purchase price, Sellers shall convey the Real Estate to Buyers or their assignees, by <u>Warnanty</u> deed, free and clear of all liens, restrictions, and encumbrances except as provided in 1:a. through 1.d. Any general warranties of title shall extend only the date of this contract, with special warranties as to acts of Sellers continuing up to time of delivery of the deed.	
1.1. REMEDIES OF THE PARTIES. a. If Buyers fail to timely perform this contract, the Sellers may forfeit it as provided in The Code, and all payments made shall be forfeited or, at Seller's option, upon thirty days written notice of intention to accelerate the payment of the entire balance because of such failure (during which thirty days such failure is not corrected) Sellers may declare the entire balance immediately due and payable. Thereafter this contract may be foreclosed in equity; the Court may appoint a receiver; and the period of redemption after sale on foreclosure may be reduced under the conditions of Section 628.26 or Section 628.27 of The Code. b. If Sellers fail to timely perform this contract, Buyers have the right to have all payments made returned to them.	•
 c. Buyers and Sellers are also entitled to utilize any and all other remedies or actions at law or in equity available to them. d. In any action or proceeding relating to this contract the successful party shall be entitled to receive reasonable attorney's fees and costs as permitted by law. 	
12. JOINT TENANCY IN PROCEEDS AND IN REAL ESTATE. If Sellers, immediately preceding this contract, hold title to the Real Estate in joint tenancy with full right of survivorship, and the joint tenancy is not later destroyed by operation of law or by acts of the Sellers, then the proceeds of this sale, and any continuing or recaptured rights of Sellers in the Real Estate, shall belong to Sellers as joint tenants with full right of survivorship and not as tenants in common; and Buyers, in the event of the death of either Seller, agree to pay any balance of the price due Sellers under this contract to the surviving Seller and to accept a deed from the surviving Seller consistent with paragraph 10.	
13. JOINDER BY SELLER'S SPOUSE. Seller's spouse, if not a titleholder immediately preceding acceptance of this offer, executes this contract only for the purpose of relinquishing all rights of dower, homestead and distributive share or in compliance with Section 516.13 of The Code and agrees to execute the deed for this purpose.	
14. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE. Time is of the essence in this contract.	
15. PERSONAL PROPERTY. If this contract includes the sale of any personal property, the Buyers grant the Sellers a security interest in the personal property and Buyers shall execute the necessary financing statements and deliver them to Sellers.	
16. CONSTRUCTION. Words and phrases in this contract shall be construed as in the singular or plural number, and as masculine, feminine or neuter gender, according to the context.	
17. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS. See attached sheet for additional provision.

17. Additional Provision. In the event the United States Department of Agriculture determines that Walnut Township, Madison County, Iowa, is a disaster area for any crop year, Buyers shall not be required to make the principal payment due in March of the following year. In such event, Buyersshall pay the interest due on March 1st following the year which has been declared a disaster year.

The East 49 acres of the North Half (Ng) or the Southeast Guarter (SEE) excepting therefrom a tract commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter (NWg) of the Southeast Quarter (SEA), running thence West 20 rods and 16 links, thence North 16 rods and 8 links, thence Southeasterly along the public highway to place of beginning, in Section Three (3); the Northwest Quarter (NH) of the Southwest Quarter (SW) of Section Two (2); all that part of the Southwest Quarter (SW1) of the Southwest Quarter (SW) of Section Two (2) and of the Southeast Quarter (SEL) of the Southeast Quarter (SEL) of Section Three (3) included within the following description; commencing at the Southeast corner of said Southwest Quarter (SW) of the Southwest Quarter (SWa), running thence West 24 rods, thence North, 51% West, 60 rods, thence Horth, 571 West, 24 rods, thence West 36 rods, thence North 47° West, 44 rods and 22 links to the Northwest corner of said Southeast Quarter (SE) of the Southeast Quarter (SEL), thence East 160 rods to the Northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter (SW) of the Southwest Quarter (SW), thence South 80 rods to the piace of beginning; and a tract described as follows: beginning at a point on the section line 580 feet North of the Southeast corner of Section Three (3) and running thence East 166.3 feet, thence North, 55° 10' West, 456 feet, thence North, 89° West, 511.4 feet, thence South, 0° 25' West 265 feet, thence East 715 feet to the place of beginning: and the Southwest Quarter (SW) of the Northwest Quarter (NW) and the East 20 feet in width of the Northwest Fractional Quarter (NW fr.) of the Northwest Quarter (NW), and a tract described as commencing at a point 20 feet West of the Northeast corner of said Northwest Practional Quarter (NW Pr. 1) of the Northwest Quarter (NWE) and running thence West 5 rods, thence South 5 rods, thence East 5 rods, thence North 5 rods to the place of beginning, of Section Three (3); all in Township Seventy-four (74) North, Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P.H., excepting that part of the above-described land heretofore conveyed to the State of Iowa for highway purposes.
