

EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

City of Patterson, Iowa

In consideration of One Dollar and Other Valuable Consideration, hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS, and convey unto Warren Water, Inc., hereinafter referred to as GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement with the right to erect, construct, install, lay and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace and remove waterlines and appurtenances thereto, over, across and through the land of the GRANTORS situated in Madison County, Iowa, being more specifically described as follows:

A part of the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and a part of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) all in Section 29, Township 76 North, Range 26 West of the 5th P.M., Madison County, Iowa described as beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section 29, thence N 0° 00' 110.00 feet, thence N 87° 00' E 30.00 feet, thence S 0° 00' 1428.00 feet, thence S 87° 00' W 30.00 feet to the West line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 29, thence N 0° 00' 1,318.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.982 acres,

and locally known as: together with the right of ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the GRANTORS, their successors and assigns, for the purposes of this easement.

The Easement shall be 32 feet in width, the centerline of which shall be the water pipeline and the necessary appurtenances thereto.

It is agreed that, during the period of initial construction, no crop damage will be paid by the GRANTEE. The GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, hereby promise to maintain such water pipeline and any necessary appurtenances in good repair so that damage to adjacent real estate of GRANTORS, if any damage there be, will be kept to a minimum.

The grant and other provisions of this easement shall constitute a covenant running with the land for the benefit of the GRANTEE, its successors and assigns.
