The City Administrator reported that he had been contacted by Clarence Lucas, representing the Madison County Historical Society, regarding the possibility of vacating and selling Pitzer Street. The Administrator stated that Mr. Lucas had received a letter from Midwest Gas indicating that they had a gas main located in a portion of Pitzer Street.
