Section 448.1. Deed executed. Immediately after the expiration of ninety days from the date of completed service of the report provided in section 447.12 the treasurer then in office shall make out a deed for each lot or parcel of land sold and unredeemed, and deliver it to the purchaser upon the return of the certificate of purchase. The treasurer shall receive \$3.00 for each deed made by him, and may include any number of parcels of land purchased by one person in one deed, if desired by him.

Section 447.9 \*\*\*\*\* Service of such notice shall also be made by certified mail on any mortgagee, or assignee, of record, whether resident or non-resident of the county, if his address is disclosed by the recorded instrument or by a certificate showing the address of the mortgagee or assignee duly filed with the recorder, or the state of Iowa in case of an old age assistance lien by service upon the state Department of Human Services.
