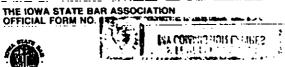

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7. CARE OF PROPERTY. Buyers shall take good care of this property, shall keep the buildings and other improvements now or hereafter placed on the said premises in good and reasonable repair and shall not injure, destroy or remove the same during the kile of this contract. Buyers shall not make any material alteration in said premises without the written consent of the Sebers. Buyers shall not use or permit said premises to be used for any idegal purpose.

B. LIENS No mechanics' ben shall be imposed upon or foreclosed against the real estate described herein

9. ADVANCEMENT BY SELLERS. If Buyers fail to pay such taxes, special assessments and insurance and effect necessary repairs, as above agreed. Sellers may, but need not, pay such taxes, special assessments, insurance and make necessary repairs, and all sums so advanced shall be due and payable on demand or such sums so advanced may, at the election of Selfers, be added to the principal amount due hereunder and so secured. (For Buyers' rights to make advancements, see paragraph 5 above.)

10. JOINT TENANCY IN PROCEEDS AND SECURITY RIGHTS IN REAL ESTATE. If and only if, the Sellers immediately preceding this sale, hold the title to the above described property in point tenancy, and such joint tenancy has not talter been destroyed by operation of few or by acts of the Sellers, this sale shall not constitute such destruction and the proceeds of this contract, and any continuing and/or recaptured rights of Sellers in said real estate, shall be and continue in Sellers as joint tenants with rights of survivorship and not as tenants in common, and Buyers, in the event of the death of one of such joint tenants, agree to pay any balance of the proceeds of this contract to the surviving Seller (or Sellers) and to accept deed sofely from him or them consistent with paragraph 14 below unless and except this paragraph is stricken from this agreement.

11. SELLERS.—Spouse, if not titleholder immediately preceding this sale, shall be presumed to have executed this instrument only for the purpose of relinquishing all rights of dower, homestead and distributive share end/or in compliance with section 561.13 Code of lower, and the use of the word "Sellers" in the printed portion of this contract, without more, shall not rebut such presumption, nor in any way enlarge or extend the previous interest of such spouse in said property, or in the sale proceeds, nor bind such spouse except as aforesaid, to the terms and provisions of this contract.

12. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE. Time is of the essence in this Agreement. Fadure to promptly assert rights of Selfers herein shall not, however, be a waiver of such rights or a waiver of any existing or subsequent default.

13. EXCEPTIONS TO WARRANTIES OF TITLE. The warranties of title in any Deed made pursuant to this contract (See paragraph 14) shall be without reservation or qualification EXCEPT. (a) Zoning ordinances; (b) Such restrictive covenants as may be shown of record; (c) Easements of record, if any; (d) As limited by paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this contract, (e) Sellers shall give Special Warranty as to the period after equitable title passes to Buyers, (f) Spouse if not titleholder, need not join in any warranties of the deed unless otherwise slipulated.

14. DEED AND ABSTRACT, BILL OF SALE. If all said sums of money and interest are paid to Sellers during the life of this contract, and all other agreements for performance by Buyer.

Sellers will execute and deliver to Buyers a <u>XXXXXX</u> Warranty Deed conveying said premises in fee simple pursuant to and in conformity with this contract; and Sellers will at this time deliver to Buyers an abstract showing merchantable little, in conformity with this contract. Such abstract shall begin with the government patent (unless pursuant to the lows State Bar Association little standards there is a lesser requirement as to period of abstracting) to said premises and shall show title thereto in Sellers as of the date of this contract; or as of such earlier date if and as designated in the next sentence. This contract supersedes the previous written offer of Buyers to buy the above described property which was

16. FORFETTURE. If Buyers (a) fail to make the payments aforesaid, or any part thereof, as same become due; or (b) fail to pay the taxes or special assessments or charges, or any part thereof, levied upon said property, or assessed against it, by any taxing body before any of such items become deinquent; or (c) fail to keep the property insured, or (d) fail to keep it in reasonable repair as herein required, or (e) fail to perform any of the agreements as herein made or required; then selfers, in addition to any and all other legal and equitable remedies which they may have, at their option, may proceed to forfeit and cancel this contract as provided by law (Chapter 656 Code of lowa). Upon completion of such forfeiture Buyers shall have no right of reclamation or compensation for money paid, or improvements made, but such payments and/or improvements if any shall be retained and kept by Selfers as compensation for the use of said property, and/or as injundated damages for breach of this contract, and upon completion of such forfeiture, if the Buyers, or any other person or persons shall be in possession of said real estate or any part thereof, such party or parties in possession shall at once peacefully remove therefrom, or failing to do so may be treated as tenants holding over, unlawfully after the expiration of a lease, and may accordingly be ousted and removed as such as provided by law.

17. FORECLOSURE. If Buyers fail, in any one or more of the specified ways to compty with this contract, as in (a), (b), (c), (d) or (e) of numbered paragraph 16 above provided. Sellers may upon thirty (30) days written notice of Intention to accelerate the payment of the entire balance, during which thirty days such default or defaults are not removed, declare the entire balance immediately due and payable; and thereafter at the option of the Sellers this contract may then be foreclosed in equity and a receiver may be appointed to take charge of said premises and collect the rents end profits thereof to be applied as may be directed by the Court.

18. ATTORNEY'S FEES. In case of any action, or in any proceedings in any Court to collect any sums payable or secured herein, or to protect the ken or title herein of Setters, or in any other case permitted by law in which attorney's fees may be collected from Buyers, or imposed upon them, or upon the above described property. Buyers agree to pay reasonable attorneys' fees

19. INTEREST ON DELINQUENT AMOUNTS. Either party will pay interist at the highest legal contract rate applicable to a natural person to the other on all amounts herein as and after they become delinquent, and/or on cash reasonably advanced by either party pursuant to the terms of this contract, as protective disbursements.

20. ASSIGNMENT. In case of the assignment of this Contract by either of the parties, prompt notice shall be given to the other parties, who shall at the time of such notice be furnished with a duplicate of such assignment by such assignment shall not terminate the liability of the assignor to perform, unless a specific release in writing is given and signed by the other party to this Contract.

21. PERSONAL PROPERTY. If this contract includes the sale of any personal property, then in the event of the forfeiture or foreclosure of this contract, such personality shall be considered indivisible with the real estate above described; and any such termination of Buyers' rights in said real estate shall concurrently operate as the forfeiture or foreclosure hereof against all such personal property.

22. CONSTRUCTION. Words and phrases herein, including acknowledgements hereol, shall be construed as in the singular or plural number, and as masculine, feminine or neuter gender, according to the context. See paragraph 11 above, for construction of the word "Sellers."

23. SPECIAL PROVISIONS.

WAIVER OF HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION UNDER IOWA CODE SECTION 561.22
