Addendum

- 1. Buyers shall make payments to Sellers at P.O. Box 323, Winterset, IA 50273.
- Sellers shall not be required to furnish Buyers an abstract of title to said property until
 immediately prior to payment of the balance due on said Contract, on or before August 1,
 2008.
- 3. Buyers shall pay the sidewalk assessment now owing against said real estate. Payment for the sidewalk assessment shall be included in the escrow amount to be added to the monthly payment as set forth below. As soon as the sidewalk assessment is paid in full, the amount to be paid to the escrow account for the sidewalk assessment will be deleted.
- 4. In addition to the monthly payment, Buyers shall make payment to Sellers monthly with the monthly payment, an amount to provide for the payment of insurance and taxes. Initially the amount to be added to the monthly payment shall be \$65.00 for taxes, and \$40.00 for insurance. Sellers agree to create an escrow account and to pay the taxes and insurance upon said property in a timely manner.
