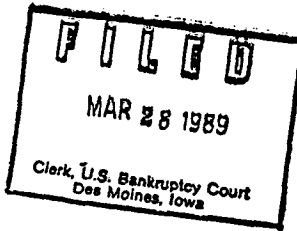

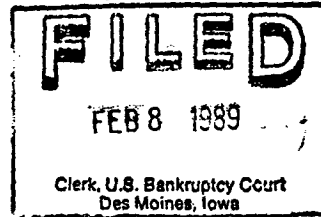

DISCHARGE OF DEBTOR

It appearing from the record that the above-named debtor is entitled to a discharge, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The debtor is released from all personal liability for debts existing on the date of commencement of this case, or deemed to have existed on such date pursuant to Section 348(d) of the Bankruptcy Code (Title 11, United States Code).

 - a. Debts determined nondischargeable by the Bankruptcy Court pursuant to Section 523 (a) (2), (4), and (6) of the Bankruptcy Code; and
 - b. Debts which are nondischargeable pursuant to Section 523(1), (3), (5), (7), (8), and (9) of the Bankruptcy Code.
3. This order does not affect any pending complaint to have a debt declared nondischargeable pursuant to Section 523(a) (2), (4), and (6) of the Bankruptcy Code, nor does it prohibit filing of a complaint under Section 523(a) (1), (3), (5), (7), (8), and (9) of the Bankruptcy Code.
4. All creditors are prohibited from attempting to collect any debt that has been discharged in this case.
5. By virtue of Section 525 of the Bankruptcy Code, no government unit or private employer may terminate the employment of or discriminate with respect to employment against the debtor solely because relief was sought in the Bankruptcy Court.

FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
AND JUDGMENT ENTRY

NOW, on this 28th day of April, 1986, this matter comes on before this Court, the Court having heard the testimony of the witnesses, statements of counsel and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and orders:

1. The Plaintiff is an Iowa corporation with its principal place of business in Knoxville, Iowa.
2. The Defendant, Marvin R. Mitchell, is an individual residing in Winterset, Madison County, Iowa.
3. On or about June 19, 1985, the Plaintiff and the Defendant entered into a written agreement for the lease of a 1984 Kann 42-foot aluminum grain hopper trailer.
4. A copy of said agreement is attached to the Plaintiff's Petition, marked "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by this reference.
5. Subsequent to the execution of the aforementioned lease agreement, the Defendant, Marvin R. Mitchell, took possession of the trailer in question and retained possession of the same on a continual basis through September 9, 1985.
6. Under the terms and conditions of the aforementioned lease agreement, the Defendant was obligated to pay to the Plaintiff the sum of \$140.00 per week as and for rent.
7. The Defendant failed to pay all rent due on said trailer to the Plaintiff, and after allowing the Defendant all credits, there remains due and owing the Plaintiff the sum of \$1,150.00, as and for delinquent rent.
8. The Plaintiff is entitled to judgment against the Defendant for the sum of \$1,150.00.

(1)

9. Under Article 3 of the aforementioned lease agreement, the Defendant, Marvin R. Mitchell, was responsible for any and all damages above normal wear during the term of said lease.

10. During the time period in which the Defendant had possession of the trailer in question, said trailer sustained extraordinary wear and damages, the cost of which repairs totalled \$7,225.00.

11. This Court finds that each of the items numbered 1 through 10 of Plaintiff's Exhibit 3, except items 2 and 6, were all as a direct result of the actions and inactions of the Defendant or his agents.

12. The fair market value of the trailer immediately prior to the lease agreement was \$14,000.00.

13. The fair market value of the trailer immediately subsequent to the lease agreement was \$8,500.00, as established by the auction sale of said trailer.

14. The difference in the fair market value prior to the lease and subsequent to the lease, of \$5,500.00, is directly attributable to the damages the trailer sustained while in possession of the Defendant.

15. As stated in Long v. McAllister, 319 NW2d 256, 261 (Iowa 1982), the measure of damages in a situation such as this, is the lesser of the costs to repair the damage or the diminution in the fair market value of the trailer.

16. The Plaintiff is entitled to further judgment against the Defendant for the sum of \$5,500.00 for extraordinary wear and tear the trailer sustained while in the possession of the Defendant.

17. There is no evidence to indicate the Plaintiff failed to mitigate his damages.


18. As a result of the default entered herein and Iowa Rule of Civil Procedure 101, the Defendant is not entitled to any of the set-offs claimed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Plaintiff, Mike Brooks, Inc., have and recover judgment against the Defendant,

Marvin R. Mitchell, the principal sum of Six Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$6,650.00), together with interest thereon at the rate of 10% per annum from and after December 16, 1985, and for the costs of this action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Stay issued by this Court in a calendar entry dated March 31, 1986, is hereby lifted and execution may continue to enforce this judgment.
