Pursuant to the provisions of Section 68 of the Iowa Business Corporation Act, the undersigned corporations adopt the following Articles of Merger for the purpose of merging them into one of such corporations.

ARTICLE ONE

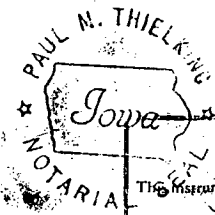
