## DEED OF RELEASE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO, a National Banking Association duly organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America (hereinafter referred to as the "Trustee"), as Trustee under Indenture of Mortgage and Deed of Trust dated as of January 1, 1939, between Chicago and North Western Railway Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and said The First National Bank of Chicago, as Supplemented and amended (Chicago and North Western Transportation Company, a Delaware corporation, being Successor Mortgagor), recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for the County of Madison, in the State of Iowa, on April 9, 1970, in Book 113, at Page 271, as Document No. 479, and in Chattel Index as Financing Statement G-3196.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the payment of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby RELEASE, REMISE, CONVEY and QUIT-CLAIM unto ELMER DECKER and GRACE DECKER, husband and wife, as joint tenants with full right of ownership in the survivor, and not as tenants in common, all of the right, title and interest and every claim and demand whatsoever which said Trustee may now have or claim to have acquired in, under, through, or by virtue of said Indenture of Mortgage and Deed of Trust, as supplemented and amended, in and to the property situated in the County of Madison, and the State of Iowa, and described as follows, to wit:

A strip of land 100 feet in width extending over and across the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 15, Township 74 North, Range 27 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, said strip of land being 50 feet in width on each side of the center line of the main track of the Chicago, St. Paul and Kansas City Railway Company (later the Chicago Great Western Railway Company, now the Chicago and North Western Transportation Company), as said main track center line was originally located and established over and across said Section 15.

This being the same real estate conveyed by Walter B. Beebee and Maria B. Beebee to Chicago, St. Paul & Kansas City Railway Company by conveyance dated February 8, 1887, and filed of record March 4, 1887, in Book 22 at Page 233 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa.

ALSO:

That part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 74 North, Range 27 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, bounded and described as follows: mencing at a point on the South line of said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, distant 50 feet Southeasterly, measured at right angles, from the center line of the main track of the Chicago, St. Paul and Kansas City Railway Company (later the Chicago Great Western Railway Company, now the Chicago and North Western Transportation Company), as said main track center line was originally located and established over and across said Section 22; thence Northeasterly parallel with said original main track center line a distance of 90 feet, more or less, to a point on the center line of a County Road, said point being the point of beginning of the parcel of land herein described; thence continuing Northeasterly parallel with said original main track center line a distance of 850 feet; thence North-westerly at right angles to the last described course a distance of 100 feet to a point distant 50 feet Northwesterly, measured at right angles, from said original main track center line; thence Southwesterly parallel with said original main track center line a distance of 820 feet, more or less, to a point on the center line of a County Road; thence Southeasterly along the center line of said County Road a distance of 108 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
