4. The mortgagor agrees to pay all and singular the taxes, assessments, levies and encumbrances of every nature heretofore or hereafter assessed against the above described real estate before they have become delinquent, and if the same be not promptly paid before they become delinquent, the mortgagee or its representative may at any time pay the same and the official receipts for moneys so paid shall be conclusive proof of the validity and amount of such taxes and assessments.

5. If now or hereafter demanded, the mortgagor agrees to pay the mortgagee additional monthly installments equal to one-twelfth of such amount as the mortgagee shall estimate to be required for the purpose of accumulating a fund with which to pay, when due, taxes, assessments and premiums on insurance policies securing said notes. 6. That the signing of this mortgage, and the note secured hereby, by the spouse of the owner is not only for the purpose of releasing dower or distributive share but also for the express purpose of creating personal liability of the spouse for the indebtedness evidenced by said note and secured by this mortgage, and that the mortgagee expressly relies upon the foregoing as a material and necessary representation and covenant by such spouse. 9.
