SUBORDINATION OF LIEN

This Subordination of Lien is made this $\frac{9^{14}}{2}$ day of $\frac{\text{February}}{2}$, 1996 by Robert J. Bauman (hereinafter referred to as "Bauman").

WHEREAS, Bauman is the holder of a lien in the amount of \$3,000.00 pursuant to a Dissolution of Marriage Decree entered in Madison County, Iowa filed November 5, 1990 in an action entitled "Linda M.
