Madison County Iowa.


WHEREAS, the City proposes to convey title of the real estate by warranty deed to Brad & Jessica Henry for the sale price of \$7,500.

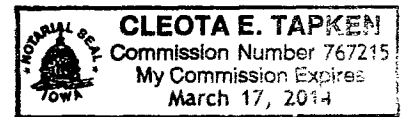
