RESOLUTION TO VOID AND ABANDON SPECIAL USE PERMIT 1172

After a properly held Public Hearing on October 1, 2013, the Madison County Board of Adjustment hereby grants a request to void and abandon SUP #1172:

On November 2, 1989 the applicant was granted Special Use Permit number 1172 to allow the construction of a private landing strip on property described as, East Half (E ½) of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Seventy Four (74) North, Rang Twenty Nine (29) West of the 5th P.M., Madison County Iowa. That permit was recorded in the Madison County Recorder's Office on November 7, 1989 under File #877 in Book 39 Page 395.

As of this date, the applicant is advising he never acted on the SUP and does not intend to act on it and construct the private landing strip and requests the SUP be voided.
