2. The following described real estate was owned by this affiant, Pearl Henkle and Walter R. Henkle, wife and husband, as joint tenants with full rights of survivorship, and not as tenants in common, at the time of Walter R. Henkle's death, to-wit:

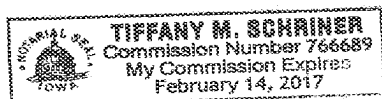

3. I hereby request that the Auditor enter this information on the transfer books pursuant to Section 558.66 of the Code of Iowa.

4. I affirmatively state that the aggregate gross value of all property interests owned by Walter R. Henkle at the time of his death was below the filing requirements of a federal estate tax return and Iowa estate tax return, and that Walter R. Henkle's estate was not subject to federal estate tax, Iowa estate tax, or Iowa inheritance tax. Form 706, United States Estate Tax Return, is not required to be filed for Walter R. Henkle. Pursuant to Section 450.22(3), Code of Iowa, an Iowa inheritance/estate tax return was not required to be filed as a result of Walter R. Henkle's death.
