The Madison County Board of Adjustment authorized the Zoning Administrator to approve on an administrative basis the *Iowa Statewide Interoperable Communications System*, or ISICS and the construction of a new emergency communications tower to a proposed height of 320'. The statewide platform provides baseline coverage across the state, covering at least 95% of the population that includes numerous upgrades or new towers at many locations throughout the state. Included with the request are several documents as well as a site location plan located in Douglas Township Section 35 at Latitude 41.335056 - Longitude -94.042139 including detailed drawings of the proposed tower (filed in the Zoning Administrator's Office).

A Special Use permit is granted as required by the Madison County Zoning Ordinance under Section 14 C (1), 14E (12) & 14E (13). Also a Variance from the Zoning Ordinance required Height Regulations - Section 9 C is granted under the provision of Section 17, D1.(c) and D4 (a) through (g).

Cause for Interpretation:

The applicant asked for an administrative review of the proposed statewide platform called the *Iowa Statewide Interoperable Communications System*, or ISICS and the construction of a new emergency communications tower to a proposed height of 320°.
