TOT septic inspection report for 2498 Carver rd. Winterset Ia. 50273

We were contacted by the realtor for the above located in 14-75-28. We did contact Madison co. environmental health dept. for maps and info, which they provide. Upon arrival we were allowed into the basement by the care taker of the property Brad Allen, we did find there to be a bathroom with vanity and stool in basement and a lift station, it was sealed up for odor control so we did test pump and run float it did pump and the check valve did shut when it stopped pumping and we did make sure it was hooked into septic system. All other plumbing did exit too the septic system. We did call Iowa one call for locates. Once outside we followed maps too find the 1500 gallon concrete two compartment septic tank there were two clean outs at each end of tank and 1 22" cleanout in middle over midwall the tank was 20" deep and we did add risers and lids over each end for future cleaning and inspection. We did find each end had plastic baffle in place as well as the midwall was in its correct position. There was slight deteriation at the water level on the effluent end of the tank not more than would be expected of a tank of this age. There was 12" of sludge in the 1st compartment and only 4" in the second and there was no water, my confusion was with so little sludge and no water did we need to pump so I called Madison County environmental health dept and spoke with leff. We decided as long as all components were in good working order and the amount of time it had been since this home was occupied, pumping would not be necessary. From there we used maps too find plast tuff tite D box it was level and 22" deep. It housed 4 laterals leaving all with speedlevelers set correctly and in 4" pvc, we did check the bottom it was not cracked. When we incorporated water into the d box all laterals took water evenly with no signs of back flow. We then walked and probed laterals in the well groomed yard, We seen no signs of ponding or staining present and there was no sewage on top of the ground. We then back filled our excavations and installed risers and lids over clean outs, we also placed a metal bar over the d box which will aid in finding it in the future. We did also measure D box is 14 ft from center of tank we will adjust this on the mapping. We then picked up our tools and spoke with the buyer and the property manager whom were on site. This would conclude our inspection and report.
