

This agreement is entered into this 30th day of March, 2018 by and between Madison County Board of Health and Joshua Boehm 622 N. 7th Street, Winterset, IA

WHEREAS, it is understood the Iowa Administrative Code 567-69 requires:

“If a private disposal system is failing to ensure effective wastewater treatment or is otherwise improperly functioning, the private sewage disposal system shall be renovated to meet current standards as adopted by the department, either by the seller or, by agreement, within a reasonable time period as determined by the county or the department, by the buyer.”


WHEREAS, the property located at 2438 Hiatt Apple Trail, Winterset, IA is improperly functioning based upon an inspection from a state certified inspector, the buyer Joshua Boehm understands the private sewage disposal system serving this property must be renovated to meet current standards.

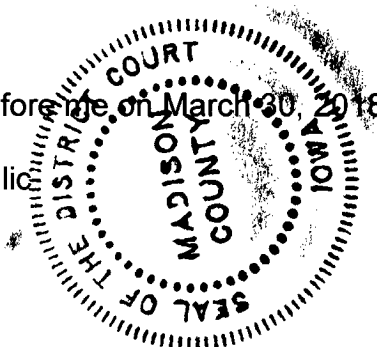
