

Explain (attach additional pages as needed): All waste water goes from house to septic. 1000 gal concrete tank in working condition. Plastic distribution box is broken and needs replaced. Hydraulic load tested the 3x100ft=300ft rock and pipe laterals with 200 gal water. Lateral #1 would not take any water. Laterals 2 and 3 took water the whole time. All laterals probed dry and clean.

Site status at conclusion of Time of Transfer inspection:

- Verify that controls are set on the appropriate mode.
- Power is on to all components.
- Revisit all components to verify lids are secure.
- Gather all tools for removal from the site.
- Verify that no sewage is on the ground surface.
